*Overall, this 2019 season is to be about much more than just baseball. For David, Reagen, Lizzy and the hundreds of children in our area who are fighting battles of their own, we will continue to teach our kids about compassion, caring and the understanding of what it means to fight.*

## LIGHT UP LIMEPORT 10 YEARS LATER—HOW DID WE GET HERE?

How do you summarize childhood events that were life-threatening and life-changing?

Let's start with the end products—two incredibly strong, brave and successful people, David Ortwein and Reagen Amand. David is now 27 years old and a nurse at UPenn Hospital. Amazingly, he started his career as a nurse at CHOP on the oncology floor where he was originally treated. David and his fiancé Jess will be married this September. Reagen is now 17 years old and will soon graduate from Owen J. Roberts High School with many accomplishments. She looks forward to starting college in the fall.

Cancer is a very private experience for the family and those closest to them. Unless you are a close friend, you would never know what these two had to endure to get here. David's junior year of baseball at Southern Lehigh was cut short by extreme fatigue, followed by an incorrect mononucleosis diagnosis. Months later, he was diagnosed

with Hodgkin's Lymphoma. Numerous rounds of chemotherapy followed, then a stem cell transplant in conjunction with eight weeks of intense radiation to become cancer-free. Reagen's experiences were excruciating. She was diagnosed and treated for acute lymphoblastic leukemia at age three, followed by a significant relapse after being off treatment for almost two years. Eleven years later, she was finally considered cancer-free.

With hundreds of hospital visits, physical suffering and mental anguish behind them, these two have become people to look up to and emulate. These WARRIORS' cancers do not define them. David is as genuine as they come. He is one of the most selfless and caring people who always looks out for others. Reagen is unpretentious and full of life, love and laughter. She is a young woman who literally fought for her life so she could live it as she does today.

Ten-year-old Lizzy Fluck is the daughter of former Spartan Bob Fluck, and her battle has just begun. After being diagnosed in November with acute lymphoblastic leukemia, Lizzy started weekly chemotherapy treatments, which cause her to miss her favorite activities: school, singing and dancing. While Lizzy's treatments and health come first these days, this FIGHTER continues teasing, dancing and playing with her sister, Georgia.

Ten years from now, I look forward to adding to the stories of these fighters and warriors at Light Up Limeport — 20 years later.

Thank you for your support of pediatric cancer and making this event a tremendous success. My sincere appreciation goes far deeper than words can express.
